### Intended Use

The picture would be used in an e-learning course about Thyroid Disease. The e-learning course is published on the internet, on a joint digital learning platform developed by the four leading Medical Faculties in Norway (University of Oslo, University of Bergen, Norwegian University of Science and Technology in Trondheim, and University of Tromsø): <https://studmed.uio.no/elaringsportalen/>

The website is used by present and former medical students to supplement classroom learning and hospital training. It is free to use and open access.

The purpose is educational: the e-learning course details normal thyroid anatomy and physiology, as well as instructions for clinical thyroid gland assessment, signs and symptoms of thyroid disease, diagnostic modalities, therapies, and self-assessments tests (quizzes and case studies), with a complete bibliography of references.
